Dear Parents and Caregivers

We have high expectations of the students at GIS to ensure that everyone can flourish and achieve success. This success will look different for everyone as we are all unique. I have spoken to the students' about these high expectations and finishing the year on a positive note. It is easy to become complacent at this time of the year and students have been reminded that they should be maintaining high expectations and striving for excellence in all that they do. 
